The rendition of artwork is a cultural enhancement activity designed to extend learning beyond the classroom and encourage exploration of the arts.

The process begins at least 3 months prior to the event, with students and parents learning about famous artists as they participate in instructional activities and hands-on learning using motor skill development, self-expression, and visual processing.

Students and parents learn about different art techniques, how to manipulate colors, work with different mediums, and implement brush strokes. Parent involvement is vital to the process of achieving the final product.


